Builder Certification Required

To qualify for the enhanced incentives from ComEd, one of the design/construction team members must be a certified passive house builder (CPHB). ComEd will reimburse **\$1,000** in training costs for builders who obtain CPHB certification. Training elements include:

- **Obtain CPHB certification** prior to construction start as prerequisite to pre-construction incentive
- Complete and return the qualifying exam
- Achieve passing grade of 75% or above
- **Submit training receipts** and a copy of CPHB certification to <u>BusinessEE@ComEd.com</u> to receive reimbursement
